the art of perfumery and method of obtaining the odors of plants science of making perfumes new edition a perfumer is a term used for an expert on creating perfume compositions sometimes referred to affectionately as a nose french le nez due to their fine sense of smell and skill in producing olfactory compositions the perfumer is effectively an artist who is trained in depth on the concepts of fragrance aesthetics and who is capable of conveying abstract concepts and moods with fragrance compositions at the most rudimentary level a perfumer must have a keen knowledge of a large variety of fragrance ingredients and their smells and be able to distinguish each of the fragrance ingredients whether alone or in combination with other fragrances as well they must know how each ingredient reveals itself through time with other ingredients the job of the perfumer is very similar to that of flavourists who compose smells and flavourants for many commercial food products

in 1948 i was posted as a political officer to a remote part of south west arabia on the edge of the great desert called the empty quarter in valleys made fertile by seasonal flood waters lay the remains of an ancient civilization i found inscriptions and the ruin sites of towns palaces and temples almost buried under the sand dunes were the tumbled walls of a great city from here two thousand years before huge camel caravans had trudged their way along 1600 miles of burning sand and rocks to petra and gaza burdened with a most precious cargo frankincense myrrh and other perfume materials for the courts temples and perfume shops of rome my book frankincense and myrrh delved into the details of this romantic trade and led to a broader interest in the perfumes of ancient times then researching on behalf of a perfume house into the arab contribution to perfumery i came across the collection of perfume recipes assembled by the arab philosopher scientist yaqub al kindi

which have never been translated into english some which i have translated myself are now included in an appendix to this book i realized that in that work i had found key evidence to demonstrate how the medieval arab perfume makers had been the bridge in perfume history between ancient and modern times perfumery could now be seen as an art with a continuous history of development since the dawn of civilization

what is important to evaluate when i smell a perfume how can i recognize the raw materials chypre oriental or woody how can i understand which olfactory family it belongs to how do i recognize a beautiful perfume perfume is an extraordinarily powerful means of expression the voice of a well crafted fragrance can take your breath away transport you back in time evoke dreams visions and desires but decoding its language may be tricky understanding the perfume language will help you make wiser purchase choices but also to find your perfect match or many possible matches according to your evolving tastes the perfume language is a pleasantly informative and non technical manual leading the reader on an exploration journey among natural and synthetic raw materials accords pyramids structures distribution and marketing dynamics the perfume language allows the reader to clarify codes concepts and terms often used incorrectly it contains a rich bibliography webgraphy and offers several exploration itineraries among the fragrances currently present in stores with the aim of helping the reader to select what to wear with the competence of a real expert marika vecchiattini is a technically trained consultant an author and a blogger her perfume blog bergamotto e benzoino bilingual eng ita was opened in 2006

by universal consent the physical faculties of man have been divided into five senses seeing hearing touching tasting and smelling it is of matter pertaining to the faculty of smelling that this book mainly treats of the five senses that of smelling is the least valued and as a consequence is the least tutored but we must not conclude from this our own act that it is of insignificant importance to our welfare and happiness by neglecting to tutor the olfactory nerve we are constantly led to breathe impure air and thus poison the body by neglecting the warning given at the gate of the lungs persons who use perfumes are more sensitive to the presence of a vitiated atmosphere than those who consider the faculty of smelling as an almost useless gift in the early ages of the world the use of perfumes was in constant practice and it had the high sanction of scriptural authority the patrons of perfumery have always been considered the most civilized and refined people of the earth if refinement consists in knowing how to enjoy the faculties which we possess then must we learn not only how to distinguish the harmony of color and form in order to please the sight the melody of sweet sounds to delight the ear the comfort of appropriate fabrics to cover the body and to please the touch but the smelling faculty must be shown how to gratify itself with the odoriferous products of the garden and the forest

during the many years of its publication and subsequent revisions paul jellinek s book has been the standard work on its subject this new edition translated into english for the first time was conceived in response to the increased interest in recent years in perfumes and the sense of smell this interest has come not only from within the highly competitive perfumery industry but also from psychologists and market researchers the original text has impressively withstood the test of time and the approach of this new book has been to supplement it with chapters that are now of critical importance but which were only touched upon in the original book a market researcher looks at why people use perfumes a psychologist examines the motivation of perfume choice another psychologist discusses odours and a perfumer looks at the effects of odours on human experience and behaviour in the final chapter the editor compares the original author s views with those of today s experts and suggests which aspects are still valid and in what areas divergent views now prevail this book is written principally to provide a scientific basis to the craft of perfumery and to enable formulators and marketeers to understand why the smells they create and sell have the effect they do it allows a systematic approach to the development of these
