explained finally the legal situation of the guide dogs especially in Switzerland is considered the second part is dedicated to answering questions and proving hypotheses that were set up previously one first hypothesis deals with the question of whether the education of guide dogs is adequate and whether the dogs are thus sufficiently reliable the second hypothesis deals with the personal judgment of the blind persons on the value of a guide dog in their lives and the third hypothesis addresses the time consumed of having a guide dog with my last hypothesis I want to figure out if guide dog handlers are satisfied with their mobility help or not an interview with a puppy raiser interviews with guide dog handlers a visit to a guide dog school and a survey to white stick users were very helpful for this the results of the different investigations are evaluated and discussed at the end the paper looks again at the hypotheses and questions formulated before the conducting of the practical part the work finishes with a rough overview it is possible for anyone interested to read the complete interviews as they are included in the appendix
